## Christmas Crochet Along „HAPPY SNOW MAN“

### MEASUREMENTS

13.5 cm x 8 cm

### TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk  
Shade 001 (white) 25 g  
Shade 024 (smokey orange) 25 g  
Shade 029 (wine red) 25 g  
Shade 043 (ivy) 25 g  
Shade 073 (wood) 25 g  
3 mm Ricorumi hook  
Rico stitch markers  
Rico tapestry needle  
4 Ricorumi Eye buttons, 5 mm  
Rico toy stuffing

### TENSION

22 sts and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm

### CARROT NOSE

With smokey orange, working into magic ring, 4 dc. Cont working in a spiral.

Rnd 1: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 2 times. 6 sts.

Rnd 2: 6 dc.

Rnd 3: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 2 times. 8 sts.

Fasten off and break yarn, leaving long tail.

Set aside.

### SNOWMAN BODY

In white, working into magic ring, 8 dc. Cont working in a spiral. Fill with stuffing as you go.

Rnd 1: [2 dc into next st] 8 times. 16 sts.

Rnd 2: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 3: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times. 32 sts.

Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times. 40 sts.

Rnd 5: [4 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times. 48 sts.

Rnd 6 – 14: 48 dc.

Rnd 15: [4 dc, dc2tog] 8 times. 40 sts.

Rnd 16: [3 dc, dc2tog] 8 times. 32 sts.

Rnd 17: [2 dc, dc2tog] 8 times. 24 sts.

Insert two Ricorumi eye buttons, one between Rnd 8 – 9 and the other, directly above, between Rnd 12 – 13.

### SNOWMAN HEAD

Cont from Rnd 17 of the body.

Rnd 18: 24 dc.

Rnd 19: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times = 32 sts.

Rnd 20: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times = 40 sts.

Rnd 21 – 27: 40 dc.

Rnd 28: [3 dc, dc2tog] 8 times = 32 sts.

Rnd 29: [2 dc, dc2tog] 8 times = 24 sts.

Sew carrot nose onto the head, directly above the buttons, with the top of the carrot at rnd 24.

Insert safety eyes on either side of the carrot nose, about 9 sts apart, between rnd 23 – 24. Cont to stuff the head and body.

Rnd 30: [1 dc, dc2tog] 8 times = 16 sts.

Rnd 31: Dc2tog 8 times = 8 sts.

Use yarn needle to close final sts. Fasten off and break yarn, weaving in end.

### STICK ARMS (MAKE 2)

With wood, leaving long starting tail, ch 6.

Row 1: Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch st. [Ch 3, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch] 2 times. Dc in remaining 4 ch sts from original ch 6. Fasten off and break yarn, leaving tail for attaching. Sew to each side of snowman.

### HAT

#### BRIM

With red, ch 4.

Row 1: Htc in 2nd ch from hook and each across = 3 sts. Ch 2, turn.

Rows 2 - 23: In back loops only, 3 htc. Ch 2, turn. After last row, do not ch 2, but turn and work 3 sl sts into both the back loops of Row 23 and the original ch sts, to form a round band.

#### BODY OF HAT

Switch to ivy, but do not break wine red yarn.

Row 1: Ch 1 and turn so you will be working into the sides of the hat brim. Dc evenly around (this amounts to about 3 sts for every 2 ribs). Sl st into ch 1. = 32\* sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, 32 dc. Sl st into ch 1.

Row 3 - 4: With red (do not break green yarn), ch 1, 32 dc. Sl st into ch 1.

Row 5: With green, ch 1, [2 dc, dc2tog] 8 times = 24 sts. Sl st into ch 1.

Row 6: Ch 1, 24 dc. Sl st into ch 1.

Row 7: With red, ch 1, [1 dc, dc2tog] 8 times = 16 sts. Sl st into ch 1.

Row 8: Ch 1, 16 dc. Sl st into ch 1.

Row 9: With green, dc2tog 8 times = 8 sts.

Sl st, then fasten off and break yarn, weaving in all ends.

#### BALL

With ivy, working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 1: 2 dc in each st = 12 sts.

Rnd 2: [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 3 times = 15 sts.

Rnd 3: 15 dc.

Rnd 4: [3 dc, dc2tog] 3 times = 12 sts. Add a small amount of stuffing.

Rnd 5: Dc2tog 6 times = 6 sts. Sl st to fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Use yarn needle to close final sts. Use yarn tail to sew ball to top of hat.

### SCARF

With ivy, ch 4.

Row 1: Htc in 2nd ch from hook and each across = 3 sts. Ch 2, turn.

Rows 2 - 36: In back loops only, 3 htc. Ch 2, turn. After last row, do not ch 2. Fasten off, breaking yarn. Weave in all ends. Wrap around snowman's neck and secure with a st if desired.

### ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

ch – chain

htc – half treble crochet

dc – double crochet

rnd – round

sl st – slip stitch

st(s) – stitch(es)

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
