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SIZE

12 cm

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk
Shade 002 (cream) 25 g
Shade 029 (weine red) 25 g
Shade 044 (grass green) 25 g
Shade 052 (light brown) 25 g
Shade 011 (pink) small amount for cheeks
Small amount of black embroidery thread/yarn
3 mm Ricorumi hook
Rico stitch markers
Rico needle
Rico synthetic stuffing
Ricorumi eye button 8 mm

BAUBLE

Using wine red.

Working into magic ring, 8 dc. Cont working in a spiral. Fill with stuffing as you go.

Rnd 1: [2 dc into next st] 8 times = 16 sts.

Rnd 2: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times = 24 sts.

Rnd 3: [2 dc, 2dc into next st] 8 times = 32 sts.

Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times = 40 sts.

Rnd 5: [4 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times = 48 sts.

Rnd 6 – 14: 48 dc.

Rnd 15: [4 dc, dc2tog] 8 times = 40 sts.

Rnd 16: [3 dc, dc2tog] 8 times = 32 sts.

Rnd 17: [2 dc, dc2tog] 8 times = 24 sts.

Do not close body any further start with Pudding here.

PUDDING

Using light brown and starting at the top. Follow instructions for bauble up to and including rnd 14.
Rnd 15 – 17: 48 dc.

Place Ricorumi eye buttons now between rnds 13 – 14 approx. 13 sts apart.

Rnd 18: [4 dc, dec2tog] 8 times. 40 sts.

Rnd 19: [3 dc, dec2tog] 8 times. 32 sts.

Rnd 20: [2 dc, dec2tog] 8 times. 24 sts.

Finish off leaving a long tail. Stuff the head now. Sew the open end of the head to the open end of the bauble.

ICING

Using cream. Working into a magic ring 6 dc.

Rnd 1: [2 dc into the next st] 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 2: [1 dc, 2 dc into the next st] 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 3: 1 dc, 2 dc into the next st, [2 dc, 2 dc into the next st] 5 times, 1 dc. 24 sts.

Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc into the next st] 6 times. 30 sts.

Rnd 5: 2 dc, 2 dc into the next st, [4 dc, 2 dc into the next st] 5 times, 2 dc. 36 sts.

Rnd 6: [5 dc, 2 dc into the next st] 6 times. 42 sts.

Rnd 7: 3 dc, 2 dc into the next st, [6 dc, 2 dc into the next st] 5 times, 3 dc. 48 sts.

Rnd 8 – 9: 48 dc.

Rnd 10: [1 dc, 2 htr into the next st, 1 tr, (2 dtr into the next st) twice, 1 tr, 2 htr into the next st, 1 dc] 6 times.

Sl st into the first st of the rnd to finish off.

Sew the icing to the top of the head.

COLLAR

Using wine red and working in rows.

Row 1: ch 27, dc into the 2nd ch from the hook and each ch along. 26 sts. Ch 2, turn.

Row 2: 3 tr in each st. 78 sts.

Finish off, place the collar around the neck then sew the ends of the collar together.

HOLLY (MAKE 3)

Using grass green.

Ch 7, dc in the 2nd ch from the hook [tr, picot, tr] in the next st, dc in the next st [tr, picot, tr] in the next st, dc in the next st.

dc x 2 into the last ch, picot, dc into the same ch.

You will now be turning to work up the other side of the ch.

Dc into the next st, *[tr, picot, tr] into the next st, dc into the next* repeat between ** finish off and leave a tail long enough to sew the leaf to the pudding.

BERRY (MAKE 2)

Using wine red.

Rnd 1: Working into a magic ring 8 dc.

Rnd 2 – 3: 8 dc.

Finish off leaving a long tail. Weave through the 8 sts and pull tight to close.

Sew leaves and berries to the top of the head.

CHEEK (MAKE 2)

Using pink.

Working into a magic ring 6 dc, pull the ring tight, sl st into the 1st st to finish off. Sew the cheeks to the face.

BOW

Using grass green.

Working into a magic ring, [ch 2, 4 tr, ch 2, sl st into the ring] twice. Finish off leaving an extra-long tail and use it to wrap around the middle of the bow. Secure at the back with a double knot. Sew to the bauble.

TO MAKE UP

Take a length of grass green yarn and make little stitches around the bauble to decorate.

Embroider a smile using black embroidery thread/ yarn.

ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

approx – approximately

BLO – back loop only

ch – chain

cont – continue

dc – double crochet

dc2tog – double crochet 2 sts together (decrease)

htr – half treble crochet

rnd – round

sl st – slip stitch

st(s) – stitch(es)

t-ch – turning chain

tr – treble crochet

ws – wrong side

[] – work stitches in brackets for the specified number of times



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
