TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk Shade 001 (white) 25 g Shade 033 (light blue) 25 g Shade 035 (midnight blue) 25 g Ricorumi Spray dk Shade 010 (grey) 25 g Ricorumi Lamé Shade 001 (silver) 10 g Ricorumi crochet hook 2.5 mm Rico embroidery needle Rico stitch marker Tapestry needle Ricorumi Button Eyes 8 mm Rico synthetic stuffing

TENSION

24 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm

BODY

In white, working into a magic ring, 8 dc. Cont working in a spiral. Fill with stuffing as you go along. Rnd 1: [2 dc into next st] 8 times. 16 sts. Rnd 2: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times. 24 sts. Rnd 3: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times. 32 sts. Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times. 40 sts. Rnd 5: [4 dc, 2 dc into next st] 8 times. 40 sts. Rnd 5: [4 dc, dc2tog] 8 times. 40 sts. Rnd 15: [4 dc, dc2tog] 8 times. 32 sts. Rnd 16: [3 dc, dc2tog] 8 times. 32 sts. Rnd 17: [2 dc, dc2tog] 8 times. 24 sts. Cont with Head.

HEAD

Cont working in a spiral. Fill with stuffing as you go along. Rnd 1: [2 dc into next st] 24 times. 48 sts. Rnd 2: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 12 times. 60 sts. Rnds 3 - 8: 60 dc. Rnd 9: [8 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 54 sts. Insert Button eyes between rnds 9 and 10, 11 sts apart. Rnds 10 - 14 : 54 sts. Rnd 15: [7 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 48 sts. Rnd 16: [6 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 42 sts. Rnd 17: 42 dc. Rnd 18: [5 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 36 sts. Rnd 19: [4 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 30 sts. Rnd 20: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts. Rnd 21: [2 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts. Rnd 22: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts. Rnd 23: [dc2tog] 6 times. 6 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With a tapestry needle thread tail through rem 6 sts, pull tight and weave in ends.

EAR (MAKE 2)

In grey, working into a magic ring, 6 dc. Cont working in a spiral.

Christmas Crochet Along "JOLLY CHRISTMAS BUNNY"

Do not fill with stuffing. Rnd 1: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 9 sts. Rnd 2: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 12 sts. Rnd 3: 12 dc. Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 15 sts. Rnd 5: 15 dc. Rnd 6: [4 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 18 sts. Rnd 7: 18 dc. Change to white. Rnd 8: [5 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 21 sts. Rnd 9: 21 dc Rnd 10: [6 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 24 sts. Rnds 11 - 12: 24 dc. Rnd 13: [6 dc, dc2tog] 3 times. 21 sts. Rnd 17: [5 dc, dc2tog] 3 times. 18 sts. Lay work flat and close opening with 9 dc through both lavers. Fold top in half and work 4 dc through both layers. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

ARM (MAKE 2)

In grey, working into a magic ring, 6 dc. Cont working in a spiral. Do not fill with stuffing. Rnd 1: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 9 sts. Rnds 2 – 3: 9 dc. Change to white Rnds 4 – 7: 9 dc. Lay opening flat and close with 4 dc through both layers. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

HAT

In light blue, make 4 ch + 2 t-ch, turn. Rnd 1: BLO, 1 tr in 3rd ch from hook, 3 tr, turn. Rnds 2 - 24: 2 ch (does not count as st), BLO, 4 tr. turn. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Use tail to sew short ends together to form a ring for ribbing. In light blue working into top of ribbing, 48 dc. Cont working in a spiral. Rnd 1: 48 dc. Rnd 2: 16 dc, 6 ch, miss next 6 sts, 4 dc, 6 ch, miss next 6 sts. 16 dc. 48 sts. Change to midnight blue. Rnd 3: 48 dc. Change to light blue. Rnd 4: [6 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 42 sts. Rnd 5: Working 1 st in light blue, 1 st in midnight blue alternately, 42 dc. Change to light blue. Rnd 6: [5 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 36 sts. Change to midnight blue. Rnd 7: 36 dc. Change to light blue. Rnd 8: 36 dc. Rnd 9: [4 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 30 sts. Rnd 10: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts. Rnd 11: [Dc2tog] 12 times. 12 sts. Rnd 12: [Dc2tog] 6 times. 6 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With a tapestry needle thread tail through rem 6 sts, pull tight and weave in ends.

Make a pompon using midnight blue and silver.

SCARF

In light blue, make 46 ch, close to a rnd with a sl st into first ch. Cont working in a spiral.

Rnd 1: 46 dc. Change to midnight blue. Rnd 2: 46 dc. Change to light blue. Rnd 3: 46 dc. Rnd 4: Working 1 st in light blue, 1 st in midnight blue alternately, 46 dc. Change to light blue. Rnd 5: 46 dc. Fasten off, weave in ends. *With rs facing, using silver, join yarn to first row of Scarf, FLO 46 sl st along row (loosely worked), fasten off. Rep from * for last row. Weave in ends.

TO MAKE UP

Using black embroidery thread and embroidery needle, embroider eyebrows above eyes and nose between eyes as illustrated. Sew parts together, using end tails. Sew pompon to Hat. Place Hat on Head to mark position of Ears where slits are located. Sew Ears to Head as marked. Sew Arms to Body below Head as illustrated. Place Scarf round neck and sew ends together.

ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

approx. – approximately BLO – back loop only ch – chain dc – double crochet dc2tog – double crochet 2 sts together (decrease) FLO – front loop only rnd – round sl st – slip stitch st – stip stitch st – stitch tr – treble crochet [] – work stitches in brackets for the specified number of times
